Dear Parent(s) and/or Guardian(s):

It is our policy that each student attend the Summer Academy for the entirety of its duration: July 8th to August 9th. Parents/Guardians should plan vacations prior to the Academy or after the program has concluded, as much as is possible and feasible given one's individual work and life circumstances. Students are expected to be on campus by 8:15 A.M. so that classes can begin promptly at 8:30 A.M. Students must be picked up or leave the campus (if they have permission to leave on their own) by 4:00 P.M. since we do not have provisions for extended care after the Academy ends. We take great care to be respectful of the Northeastern University campus, so we have a zero acceptance policy for loitering or disruptive behavior.

Must Pick-Up or Walk Home: 4:00 P.M.

Tardy/Absence Policy:

We understand that illness and family emergencies come up, so we ask that parents and/or guardians call us early in the morning if their student will be late or absent, so that we know why a student is missing from the classroom. We take attendance in the morning and call parents of tardy or absent students if we have not heard from the parent(s) or guardian(s) by 9:00 A.M.
