**A key measurement tool in BASB's suite is NIOST's APT (Assessment of Program Practices Tool.) This tool provides programs with a 3rd party observation for insight into program quality. BASB is building a citywide learning and evaluation network by certifying members of the BASB community to conduct APT observations. Current participants say that being a part of this citywide network builds capacity in their organizations to incorporate best-in-class program performance practices, facilitates an opportunity to learn from a diverse network of programs, and provides professional development and networking opportunities with peers from other organizations.

This upcoming school year will include several training sessions for staff at your program to become certified observers. **Unless you are already certified, you are only required to participate in one training** (either in September, January, March, or May.) Each training session runs 1.5 days, followed by a site visit with a Master Observer to test for reliability. Those who pass will be asked to conduct a solo APT observation at a site.
