- Turn in all electronic devices (cell phones, music devices, tablets, laptops, etc.) upon arriving on campus.

BE PREPARED

- Wear appropriate clothing: NO exposed undergarments, clothing with inappropriate logos, exposed back, buttocks, bellies, or cleavage, leggings or tights, shorts/skirts/dresses that are too short.
- Finish breakfast before entering classroom by 8:30
- Pack a lunch if not participating in the BPS: free lunch program – There will be **no** opportunity to buy food on the Northeastern University campus.
- Come with a daily attitude that makes you feel ready to learn and grow!
- Think before acting and exercise good judgment.

Consequences:

Any behavior that seriously threatens the safety and wellbeing of oneself and/or other participants or that seriously interferes with the Academy’s goals and relationship with Northeastern University will lead to immediate dismissal. The Staff reserves the right to interpret the rules, and if a student is dismissed for inappropriate behavior, there is no refund of tuition or money.
